**To introduce an example:**

for example □

for instance □ in this case

on this occasion □

to illustrate □

to demonstrate

this can be seen □ when/where . . .

take the case of

**To indicate time**

immediately □

thereafter □

formerly

prior to □

previously □

finally

then □

soon □

during

at that time □

before, after

**To indicate sequence or order:**

first, second etc. □

at this point □

followed by

next, last, finally □

previously, subsequently □

after that

first of all □ and then □

next, before, after

concurrently □

at this time □

meanwhile

simultaneously □ □

**To logically divide an idea:**

firstly, secondly, thirdly □

Initially, subsequently, ultimately □

first, next, finally
